We are extending the afternoon service departing from Woy Woy – Lintern St at 3:30 pm (previously it was departure 3:45 pm to Veterans Hall, Saratoga only). This applies Monday – Friday. There are no other timetable changes.

FARES UPDATE

- **Woy Woy- Empire Bay:**

As per the IPART determination, which sets fares for public transport, there will be a slight increase in fares as from 1st JUNE 2008.

Woy Woy to Empire Bay

Adult: \$6.20 One Way / \$12.40 Return

Child, Student, Concession, Pensioners & Seniors: \$3.10 One Way / \$6.20 Return

Empire Bay to Davistown

Adult: \$3 One Way / \$6 Return

Child, Student, Concession, Pensioners & Seniors: \$2 One Way / \$4 Return

There is NO increase in Ferry 10 passes.
