As there are only 36 such areas left , concerns are raised as to how dog owners can access these other areas ( especially if you are frail/elderly or have no transport – bus drivers don't like dogs!) . We need to support and encourage responsible dog ownership, and we also need to support any perceived endangered flora or fauna- in other words we need to co habitat – and not shut the gate!

If you are a dog owner , or just a concerned member of the public, we encourage you to join CC BARCS –this way you can be part of a like minded group and help us to defend our rights as dog owners to exercise our dogs – and ourselves!
